

# Family Money Buzz - Energy Detectives

## Content

An interactive online financial education programme for 9-11 year olds focusing on energy efficiency.

Family Money Buzz – Energy Detectives is an independent learning programme addressing energy consumption and how it impacts both the environment and the cost of living. Supported by UK Power Networks, it aims to reduce fuel poverty whilst improving financial capability.

These activities can be introduced to young people by parents or incorporated into a teachers' adapted curriculum.



## Key Facts




Format: 1 x 60-minute session - Expert-led videos explaining key concepts - Investigations and activities.

Target group: 9 – 11 year olds.

Cost: Free.

Funder: UK Power Networks.

## Sessions cover:

-  **Recognition of costs:** Where energy comes from, and understanding wasting energy can be costly.
-  **How to reduce waste:** Looking at a number of practical ways to reduce common energy costs.
-  **Understanding consequences of use:** In terms of financial and environmental impact.

Young people are led through a digital investigation with Detective Wes, a Manga inspired energy hero, to explore energy usage in their home. They discover clues to crack the case of energy waste and uncover ways to cut costs. It includes activities and videos, and uses literacy and critical thinking skills.

Family Money Buzz – Energy Detectives is part of a targeted school programme and complements our Family Money Twist home learning programmes for Years 1-2 and 3-6. Our online sessions are underpinned by directly delivered programmes for both upper and lower Key Stage 2 pupils in primary schools.
