Content

71% of young people are worried about the the cost of living crisis.This includes rising energy bills.

Fuel finance is a highly interactive session for 9-11 year olds who have received Money Twist programme and are living in areas served by the Gas Distribution Networks.



Students learn about energy consumption and how it impacts both the environment and their cost of living. This session is complemented by family activities and a MyBnk comic book that encourage students to share their knowledge on gas safety, challenge themselves to reduce energy use, and think about their impact on real world issues.

Vihaan, 10

Vihaan is a primary school student in year 5 who attended our Fuel finance session, covering energy efficiency and saving money. Here's what he thought about the session:

"I liked fuel finance because I learned a lot about saving energy and protecting the earth. I also learnt that there are fuels that are bad for the earth and that there are other forms of energy apart from fossil fuels. For example, I didn't know that wind was also a form of energy. I also found out about how the costs are rising. I was amazed to learn that in 2019 everything cost less and now everything is much more expensive. These rising costs are impacting the grown-ups in my life a lot, especially, with utilities. Right now, people are struggling a lot because the prices are way higher.

In today's session, my favourite activity was the oath.We had to take an oath that we will do our best to protect the earth.We also filled in a worksheet where we discussed the different steps, we could take to protect the earth.

I think young people like me should attend fuel finance so that when we are older, we will know how to protect the earth from getting damaged. When I am older, I will stop using electricity and get solar panels because it is renewable and does not cost as much. I will become better at saving energy and money. Starting from now, before I go to sleep, I will check all the light switches and taps are turned off".
